Tyler Announces The Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award National Player of the Week

TYLER, Texas – Alabama quarterback Jalen Hurts has been named The Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award National Player of the Week for the eleventh week of the college football season.

The freshman quarterback had a record setting day as #1 Alabama beat Mississippi State 51-3. Hurts became the first player in Alabama football's storied history to throw for 300 yards (347) and rush for 100 yards (100) in the same game.

Hurts completed 28-of-37 passes (75.7 percent) for 347 yards passing and four touchdowns. He also rushed 11 times for 100 yards and one touchdown, averaging 9.1 yards per carry. Hurts accounted for 447 yards of total offense, which ranks as the third-best total in school history.

Jalen Hurts is a graduate of Channelview High School, Channelview, Texas.
